This term's topic: Mapping Caesar

The children will study the story of Shakespeare's Julius Caesar this term. Alongside this in geography, we will be using skills to map the extent of the Roman Empire in Britain. The children will find out about the lines of longitude and latitude, use 4 and 6 figure grid references and apply these skills to Ordnance Survey maps.

Reading

It is so important that your child reads at home at least 5 times a week. This should be an enjoyable part of their day where they can relax and enjoy some quiet time and a bit of escapism.

Children will have a book that they choose at school to take home. Any reading done at home is then recorded in their reading record books.

The reading record book should be brought into school each day with the child's reading book. Each Friday the number of reads will be counted in the reading record book. This information is used for the 'Donut Stop Reading' school competition which has been set up to encourage reading across the school. There will also be a class winner each week who has shown that they read consistently at home.
