Weekly spelling homework will continue, linked to the spelling rules we are learning in class. Please support your child by practising using the 'Look, cover, say, write' sheets.

PE

PE will take place on Tuesdays and Fridays. Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school; it is helpful if it stays here during the week.

Forest School

Class 2's Forest School session will take place on Thursday 5th March.

Coats, Wellies and Water Bottles

Please ensure your child brings a warm, waterproof coat to school each day, ideally with a hood. As we use our outdoor areas regularly, please also provide wellies to keep at school. Children also need to bring a named water bottle each day.
