Welcome back to the Summer Term. We hope that you all had a good break and have not eaten too many chocolate eggs!

This term our whole school quest is 'Let's Grow Together'. Attached is a curriculum overview to show you some of the areas that we will be covering throughout the Summer Term.

During May the children in Year Two will be taking their SATs. These tests provide information on the progress of your child compared to other children the same age nationally. The tests consist of four papers. Two English Reading papers, one with a short text and questions the other has a longer text with separate questions. Two Maths papers, one with arithmetic questions and the other with reasoning questions. This year there will not be a statutory spelling test or a test on grammar and punctuation.
