



Class 5 Online Safety Charter

In Class 5, we have thought carefully about healthy habits whilst using technology and ways to keep ourselves safe online. We understand that we have a shared responsibility for looking after ourselves when using technology at home and in school.

To stay safe we will:

- ✓ Treat others how we wish to be treated - always be kind!
- ✓ Talk with a trusted adult if we are unsure, dislike or are worried about anything that we see online.
- ✓ Avoid using untrustworthy sites by making sure that the padlock symbol is showing to tell us it is a trusted site.
- ✓ Monitor the amount of time that we spend online.
- ✓ Ask permission from trusted adults to communicate with others. We won't meet in person or agree to do anything with people from online sources.
- ✓ Have fun using technology and being online but always be safe.
- ✓ Check with a trusted adult if we can view videos online and look for age ratings.
- ✓ Never share personal information with people we don't know including: our full name, address, passwords, phone or contact numbers, username/email, school identity, photographs or information that we hold about other people.
