The table below shows the **average progress** that our children made in each subject. Expected progress is measured at 0.0. Anything **above 0** is considered **average/good** and **above 2** is **above average/very good**.

The table below shows the **average Scaled Score** in Reading, Maths and SPAG. The average Scaled Score at Milverton School is significantly higher than the national average in Reading and Maths.
