# Milverton Community Primary and Pre-School

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Firstly, we are sorry that you have had to self-isolate and we hope that you and your family are ok. We would like to offer some form of educational support to your child if they are well enough to complete it. We have looked through the many educational resources available and believe that Oak National Academy lessons are the most suitable for this support.

The Oak website offers one English, one Maths and one 'topic' lesson each day. The support includes a video from a trained teacher, visual material and some independent learning. For English and Maths, the work is organised into two or more week blocks. It is very important that your child starts the block of work from the Monday of week 1 (of the block of work they are completing) so that there is progression in their learning and so that they can build on previous session content. For Maths, we are intending to match the units of work being covered at school with the units we ask your child to cover during their time of self-isolation.

In any English block, the texts being used are not the ones we will use in class. However, all learning is at the right level to cover the expectations of the year 1 and year 2 curriculums. As said above, Maths will mirror the learning we are doing in class as far as possible. Other 'topic' lessons will be based on expectations for the year group and standalone.

- 6. Click on the unit we are currently teaching in class. You can find this by asking your child or looking at the timetable below.
- 7. Start at 'Lesson 1'.
- 8. Progress through the lesson accordingly.






