| Day 2 | <p>Watch the video of Mrs A reading Stick Man https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCcztW-wza6fuVkxeJUo_MRA</p> <p>Write a new section of the story where Stick Man is used for something he shouldn't be! Remember to use finger spaces, full stops and capital letters (particularly for his name!) Find a stick in the garden or an outside space. Measure how long the stick is. Can you find a longer one? A shorter one? Reading: 10 minutes to an adult Mental maths Count in 2s to 20 and back down again. Can you get further than 20?</p> <p>Phonics: Work through the phonics booklet</p> |

Remember to use adjectives so that Mrs Mcdonagh and Mrs Atterton know exactly what it looks like! Set up a little stall in your bedroom. Label each toy or book with a price. Imagine you have £1 (100 pennies). What could you buy? How much change would you get?</p> | <p>Art Using anything you like (colouring crayons, felt tips, materials from around your house etc) create the most colourful piece of abstract art that you can. * For abstract art think of Bodhi's morning pictures! Discuss with a grown up what they think it is and what you intended it to be.</p> | <p>Spellings: As Monday. If you can read and spell ALL the words, select some from the third column to put into correctly punctuated sentences. Reading: 10 minutes to an adult Mental maths Count in 5s to 50 and back down again. Can you get further than 50? Phonics: Work through the phonics booklet</p> |

What was weird about it? What did it do to your house? What did it eat? What did it like to play? Write your own story about it. How tall is your animal? How long is your animal?
