





The Seasons

The Four Seasons

Vivaldi wrote a piece of music called 'The Four Seasons'. It's actually four pieces of music, one about each season.

We are going to listen to one of these pieces now.

Spring

This music is called 'Spring'.





The word tempo means the speed of the music – is it fast, slow or somewhere in the middle?

How would you describe the tempo of 'Spring'?

Be a Conductor

A conductor is someone who stands in front of an orchestra and helps them play at the correct tempo. The conductor will wave their hands, or sometimes a stick called a baton.




Dynamics

Dynamics describe the volume of music; loud or quiet, although in music, we say 'soft' instead of 'quiet'.

The dynamics of 'Spring' change through the piece.





Listen to the music again. When the music gets loud, put your hand high in the air. When the music gets softer, put your hand lower to show the change.

Be an Artist!

Vivaldi uses music to describe spring. Now you are going to create a piece of artwork based on his music.

Think about what colours you should use – bright or dull? What colours do you see a lot of in spring?
