Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back and welcome to Class 5! We hope you and the children have had an enjoyable break and are ready for the year ahead. The children are settling in really well and have got used to being back in a routine. This term our Year 5 & 6 quest is 'Something Old, Something New'. We have planned a variety of learning experiences that are on the attached quest coverage leaflet, so there is lots to look forward to over the coming weeks.

## Reading

Regular reading at home and at school makes such a difference to the educational outcomes of children and we encourage all families to listen to their children read as often as possible. The expectation within the school is to read at home at least four times a week. The children should all now have a reading record - please sign the reading records each time you hear your child read. There are some great prompts in the reading records to use as a guide for talking to your child about what they have read. We will be collecting the reading records in every Monday for monitoring. Books will be changed whenever needed and reading records alongside books can be put into the box in the classroom at any time throughout the week and the books will be changed. Reading record folders need to be in school every day please. We have a library in the classroom which includes fiction, poetry and non-fiction which the children are encouraged to access during quiet reading sessions in class. If you have an interest in volunteering your time to listen to readers in Class 5 we would love to hear from you so that we can arrange a time and sort out the necessary checks.

## Homework

In addition to reading the children will bring home their spellings weekly. New spellings will be issued on a Wednesday to be tested the following Tuesday. The spelling homework sheet needs to be returned to school on **Tuesday** with the task completed.

Weekly maths homework is also set, this will usually be on MyMaths but there will be times when a sheet will be given instead. Maths homework will be set on a **Thursday** to return no later than the following Thursday. This homework will always cover an area of learning that has already been taught and should take no more than 20 minutes (often less). Please do send an email if it is regularly taking longer so that we are aware. For all homework, house points are issued for completing on time and for writing sentences that make sense and are correctly punctuated in spelling. Please support and encourage your child to complete their homework. If there are exceptional circumstances that make it difficult for your child to complete their homework, please send a message via the class email address.

## P.E.

This half term our PE sessions will be on a Tuesday and Thursday, There will be times when additional sessions may occur, so we ask that PE kits are in school every day please. If your child has their ears pierced, earrings need to be removed for the PE session. Please ensure that your child is able to remove their piercings independently. If this is not the case, we would advise that they are removed before they arrive in school.



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## Coats and Water Bottles

We take the children out to play as often as we can, even in light rainy weather and cold weather, so it is important for the children to have a coat in school every day. We encourage children to drink plenty of water during the day, they are welcome to bring in their own named water bottle to drink from. Otherwise, cups and water are available in the classroom.

Everything that your child needs to access the curriculum is here in schools so there is no need to provide anything yourself, for example, pencil cases are not required in Year 5.

*Please endeavour to name everything that comes into school as it makes rehoming lost items much easier and avoids conflict in the event of uncertainty!*

We will have two forest school sessions this term, led by Ms Boullin. Later this half term, we have a 'Wartime Somerset' workshop booked with the South West Heritage Trust.
