## **Ref: MCC Reopening 2021**

I am sure that you are aware that the government has made further changes to its plans to reopen schools after the Christmas holiday. I recognise that very late changes, such as these, cause issues in families and so I apologise for the timing of this letter.

In line with the government announcement:

- Years 7 to 10 will be educated at home from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January. They will return to school on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January.
- Years 11 will be educated at home from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January. They will return to school on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January. Year 11 mocks will go ahead as planned, starting on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January.

Year 7 to 11 will be taught all of their lessons online while they are at home. They should log into each lesson at the usual time. Their teachers will be sending them invites to lessons, which will appear in their TEAMs calendar. All students have been shown how to access TEAMs and log into their lessons. They should also check OUTLOOK to see if their teachers have emailed them.

The children of Key Workers (for example those who work in the NHS) or children who are vulnerable can be educated in school. If your child is in either of these categories and you would like them to be educated in school, please contact our office in the first instance.
