Thank you for your support with maintaining our high standards at Moat. These include our students being in very smart school uniform and arriving at school on time. The new punctuality policy worked very well last year. The number of students who were late dropped very significantly. This year students need to be at the school gate by 8.30am, to avoid a 'same day detention'. This allows for a prompt start to learning at 8.35am. The change to the start time of the school day, was taken in response to a new government regulation about the length of the school day. The college had to increase the length of the school day by five minutes to be compliant.

We would like to wish our new Year 11 students the best of luck as they start the most important year of their education. The results in their English Literature GCSE taken at the end of year 10, were outstanding.
