If a student responds with 'No,' we follow up to check on their well-being. Support is then offered by one of our mental health first aiders or through sessions with our counsellors.

We also hold assemblies to remind students of the importance of asking for help if they feel anxious or upset. A set of helpful links is shared so that students can access support during the holiday, should they need it. Additionally, we remind them of the school's welfare email address: welfare@moat.leicester.sch.uk, which is monitored regularly over the holiday period to provide direct support if needed.
