This is my last letter of the year. I hope that it finds you safe and well. The national guidance around the covid virus changed last week, with a significant increase in safety measures. There has been no significant change to guidance about schools. However, we will continue to monitor the situation and communicate promptly if anything changes.

I have a few items to bring to your attention:

Masks

Our students are now wearing masks in school while moving around communal areas. The response to this requirement has been very positive; our students understand the need to play their part in keeping everyone in school safe. Could you ensure that you support us by ensuring that your son/daughter has their mask when they leave for school in the morning.

Lateral Flow Testing
