I hope that the term has started well for you and your children. Our staff are working very hard to deliver a very good quality of online education for all our students and I must pay tribute to their hard work and determination.

There are a few items of important information which I want to share with you in this letter:

Remote Learning (Live Lessons)

Year 7 to 11 will be taught all of their lessons online whilst they are at home. They should log into each lesson at the usual time. Their teachers will be sending them invites to lessons which will appear in their TEAMS calendar. All students have been shown how to access TEAMS and log into their lessons. They should also check OUTLOOK to see if their teachers have emailed them.

You will receive a communication each day which will tell you if any member of staff cannot teach their lesson 'live' that day. This might be because the member of staff is ill for example.

We will be taking registers each lesson and will contact you if your child does not log into lessons as required.

I have included in this letter a document that shows the times of our lessons. We have kept to our usual lesson times, to try to keep things as 'normal' as possible for our students.

Devices

If your child needs to loan a school device to access their live lessons during the school's closure, please contact the school office in the first instance. We will do our best to support you.

Key Worker/Vulnerable Students

The children of Key Workers (for example those who work in the NHS) or children who are vulnerable, can be educated in school. If your child is in either of these categories and you would like them to be educated in school, please contact our office in the first instance. Whilst in school these students will also log into their lessons as they would at home.
