As we approach the end of a long but successful half-term, I would like to share some important updates with you.

Ramadan and Eid

Many of our staff and students are currently observing the Holy Month of Ramadan, and we extend our best wishes to them. This is a significant period for the school, during which our students reflect on their values and demonstrate strong character. It is inspiring to see their personal growth throughout this time.

Mr. K. Patel has delivered an excellent assembly on our expectations for students during Ramadan, reinforcing these values.

Please note that the school will be **closed on Monday, 31st March** to minimise the amount of learning time missed while school is in session. As previously mentioned, good school attendance is essential. Therefore, students should return to school on **Tuesday, 1st April**, unless they are actively celebrating Eid on that day.

Year 11 & 10 Key Stage 4 Exams

Year 11 and Year 10 students have now completed their second set of mock exams, with encouraging results. As we approach the final stretch before their exams, we continue to support our students by:

- Providing detailed guidance to help them plan independent revision at home
- Ensuring they have their exam timetables to create structured study plans.
- Holding 'Period 7' sessions for additional study time with teachers.
- Running targeted intervention sessions during the school day.
- Offering intervention sessions during the Easter holidays.
- Supplying a wide range of virtual and paper-based revision resources.
- Providing emotional support where needed.
- Adjusting the school timetable to include extended revision sessions before each exam.

Driving Near the School

We greatly appreciate the consideration shown by most parents when driving near the school. However, we would like to remind everyone of the following safety guidelines:









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- Avoid parking on pavements to ensure safe passage for pedestrians, especially those with pushchairs or mobility aids.
- Do not park on zigzag lines or double yellow lines outside the school, as this obstructs visibility for those using crossings and causes unnecessary congestion.
- Refrain from stopping in the middle of the road to drop off or pick up students. Instead, please park safely a short distance from the school.
- Be patient during peak times. While some congestion on Maidstone Road is expected, our staff are present to supervise students and ensure their safety.
