Testing

We will be carrying out three on-site covid tests for each student. The dates of the first test were given in my previous letter (Spring Term Letter 6). The second and third test will be carried out in school between Thursday 11th March and Thursday 18th March.

After the three tests have been completed, we will be issuing students with covid test kits to test themselves at home. I will write a further letter about this in the near future.

Devices

Many of you have borrowed devices during this closure period to support remote learning. In all we were able to lend out over 300 devices. Could I ask parents who have these devices, to keep them at home at present. We will arrange to collect them during the week beginning 12th April.
