Eid

Many of our families are fasting at present due to Ramadan. Next week many of you will be celebrating Eid. We do authorise a day absence for religious observance over Eid, however, could I ask you to ensure that students only take one day off school. Any absence beyond one day, cannot be authorised. I do hope that all our families enjoy the celebration.

Year 11

We are working hard with our year 11 students to produce the evidence that will be used to award them their Key Stage 4 grades. Year 11's last day in formal school will be on Friday 28th May 2021. We will mark that day with an extended assembly and a function in school. Year 11 parents will receive another letter from Mr Holdsworth, which contains full details of the arrangements for the last few days and the support offered after half term. This includes remote access to transition courses in many subjects which will support our students move to college.

All of the Moat staff are working hard to consolidate the work covered remotely during the school closure and to cover all of the content that is in our curriculum for this term. We are determined that our students will not be disadvantaged by the school closures over the last year.
