

CORONAVIRUS INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

SCHOOL'S COMMITMENT

Our school will not close or restrict pupils unless advised to do so by Public Health England.

We are receiving regular updates on how to proceed and currently we are encouraging hand washing with the children and using a tissue for coughs and sneezes. The school is cleansed thoroughly after school each day and hand sanitizer is available in every class.

PARENT'S COMMITMENT

We would ask that if your child has 'flu-like' symptoms, and in particular a high temperature, that you contact NHS 111 for advice. DO NOT go to your doctors. The NHS and Public Health England will ascertain if the case is coronavirus or, as is most likely, seasonal cold or flu. Please contact school and let us know if the child's illness is determined as coronavirus.

Parents should not be keeping children off school unless advised to do so.
