Dear Parents

In less than two months' time, the Year 6 stayers will be taking part in their Activity Week. We are fortunate that we have been allowed to combine our Activity Week with Minster's thus enabling the children to have great days out at a lower cost. The teacher leading this at Minster is their Year 6 Teacher, Mrs A Manning. For each day, the children will be supported by a Monkton member of staff as well as Minster staff. It's also a great opportunity for them to mix with other children - a prelude to transition into Year 7.

Monday 3rd June

This day will be spent visiting the Science Museum in London. Whilst there, the children will have access to the hands-on Wonderlab gallery and will be watching the Wonder show - this contains a medley of experiments and demonstrations that are jam-packed with WOW moments and opportunities to volunteer and is designed to inspire children about science. The children will be travelling on the 09:00 train from Ramsgate to London St Pancras and will then use the London Underground. They will require a packed lunch to eat at the museum in a designated slot and if time and weather permit, we will visit Hyde Park before returning home. This will be a late arrival home as we are planning to return to Ramsgate for 17:57. All children need to be collected from Ramsgate on return.

Tuesday 4th June

This day will be spent in Minster. The children should arrive at school at the normal time where they will be taken to Minster by the designated Monkton adult. They will spend the morning completing a range of art activities. In the afternoon, we will visit the park and will return to school for our normal school home time. Children must have a packed lunch on this day.

Wednesday 5th June

This day will be spent in Minster. The children should arrive at school at the normal time where they will be taken to Minster by the designated Monkton adult and will spend the morning cooking in our very own Great Minster and Monkton Bake Off! In the afternoon, we will either be taking part in team games or having a movie afternoon - we will see what the weather is like and see what everyone would prefer © Children must have a packed lunch on this day.





Thursday 6th June

This day will be spent at Betteshanger Activity Park. The children will need to be dropped at Monkton school for 08:15 to come straight into class to be registered before leaving to get to Betteshanger for 09:15. Whilst there, they will be exploring the park on mountain bikes and undertaking the Boonies obstacle course. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and be dressed in comfortable clothing and sensible footwear. They will need to have a waterproof jacket in case of rainy weather. We will aim to be back at school for the usual time of 15:15 but will let you know if we are delayed.

Friday 7th June

This day will be spent at Wingham Wildlife Park. The children will need to be dropped at Monkton school at the usual time to come straight into class to be registered before leaving to get to Wingham for 10:00. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and be dressed in comfortable clothing and sensible footwear. They will need to have a waterproof jacket in case of rainy weather. We will aim to be back at school for the usual time of 15:15 but will let you know if we are delayed.

The full costing for the week will be £51.42. This will need to be paid by Friday 24^{th} May. If you would like to arrange to pay in 2 instalments of £25.71, please contact the school office. If you think that you will have trouble paying, please arrange a meeting with Mr Marston either by telephone or in person.

I hope you feel that this provides an exciting experience for your children. I believe that this will allow the children to have a fantastic week full of fun activities and ensure they have wonderful memories of their final year at Monkton.
