

English

This term will continue to practice writing our names and will be paying particular attention to ensure we write them using the handwriting style we have been taught at school. We will be sharing lots of stories and talk about characters, what we think will happen next and give our opinions on them. We have learnt lots of sounds now and will be introduced to some more. This term we will be practicing our blending and will start to read simple CVC words. We will also continue to practice to write our sounds down and begin to explore writing simple CVC words. We are already writing down our initial sounds! Phonics lessons will continue to be taught daily as well as our reading sessions 3 times a week.

Communication and Language

This term the children we will continue to encourage the children to share their likes and dislikes. We will be encouraging to give reasons for their opinions. As the children are now confident with one another we will have more speak and share times and other them more opportunities to present their work to one another. The children will also be introduced new language within our topics and will be helped to use them within their speech.

Maths

Every day will we have our 'Maths Mash Up' sessions where we will sing songs and play simple games to practice our counting up and down using numbers to 20. Here we will also begin to learn the days of the weeks and talk about the weather. In our Maths lessons we will be working with numbers to 10 to count, add, subitise and represent in different ways.

We will find out about the Arctic and discuss what it is like there and how it is different from where we live.
