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Other Specific Areas

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- **Understanding the World** We will be exploring and creating simple maps and learning about and comparing different forms of transport, as well as learning about less familiar types of transport. We will be testing vehicles for speed and distance, and carrying out a traffic survey.
- Expressive Arts and Design We will use a variety of resources to build and create model vehicles. We will be learning and singing songs relating to the topic.
 - **ICT** Children will be taught ICT through each strand of the curriculum and in their Child Initiated Learning
