JEROME'S CINNAMON BLONDIES!

Ingredients

- 1.1/2 cup of softened butter
- 2.1 cup of packed brown sugar
- 3.2 teaspoons of vanilla extract
- 4.1 room temperature large egg
- 5.1/3 cups of self-raising flour
- 6.1 teaspoon of brown cinnamon
- 7.1/8 teaspoons of ground nutmeg

TOPPING

- 1.1/4 teaspoon of sugar
- 2.1/4 teaspoons of grounded cinnamon

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.Preheat the oven to 180°C
- 2.Grease an 8-inch baking dish with butter
- 3.Cream butter and brown sugar until light and frothy
- 4.Beat the egg
- 5.In another bowl whisk together flour and spices until it is creamy
- **6.Spread** into the greased pan
- 7.Mix the toppings into the ingredients, sprinkle over the top
- 8.Bake until golden brown, this will take 25-30 minutes
- 9.Cool completely in pan on a wire rack
- 10. Cut into bars

Because I've worked with everyone at Monkton before and I had the opportunity to bring a variety of skills to Monkton, so we can all get better together.


Q3) Can you describe your future vision for Monkton?
