#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We be discussing our favourite things about being in Bee Class and what has made us happy and proud this year.

## Writing

The children will continue to write their sentences and will be encouraged to write as neatly as they can now. The children will be encouraged to be more independent as the final weeks progress.

#### Reading

We will continue to read at least one story a day and many of these will be focused around our topic. We will also carry on reading 1:1 with the children. Please read every day with your child. It really does have an effective on their progression. Plus, house points can be earned!

#### Sunshine and Sunflowers

For our last term together, we are going to become outside explorers. We will be planting our own flowers and vegetables. We will be searching for minibeasts. We will learn about what plants need to grow and the life cycles of caterpillars and frogs.

#### Shadows and Reflections

This mini topic is going to be lots of fun. We will be making our own shadows and exploring reflections. We will also be making lots of noise when we explore echoes.

#### Physical Development

This term, we will continue to have our structured PE sessions with our PE coach. We will be practicing all the skills we will need for sports day. We will also be practicing at different times throughout the week so please can we make sure our children have their full PE kits in school every day.

#### **Mathematics**

We will continue with our daily 'Maths Mash Up' sessions. Here we talk about days, months, weather and practice other maths skills. At the moment we are challenging ourselves to count up to 100 in these sessions as a class.

We will revise the skills we have learnt this year as well as explore some new topics such as capacity and time
