

English

In English, we will begin the term exploring the character of Cruella De Vil in 101 Dalmatians, which is also our core text for Term 1. Followed by writing conversations between Bonnie and Clyde, which we will then use to write a short story- The Bank Robbery. Moving on, we will briefly learn about riddles, writing superhero and villain riddles for others to guess, before moving onto Fairy tales. Finally, we will be exploring comic strips.

Science

Our topic in science is Plants, learning about separate parts, their purposes, and the conditions needed for plant growth. We will be developing our skills, learning how to work scientifically, carrying out accurate observations, then recording and presenting data.

Maths

Times tables will be a focus throughout this year and time will be spent in class securely learning each time table so that children will know them in the correct order, mixed up and the in the inverse. The first term will focus on developing our understanding of number and place value, moving onto methods for addition and subtraction later in Term 1.
