English

After a few assessments to see where we all are in our learning journeys, we will begin our topic, I am Warrior, which explores Ancient Rome. We will begin by learning all bout Soliloquies, where we will imagine the thoughts of Roman warriors as they prepare for battle. After we will explore play scripts followed by instructions, menus and invitations for a Roman banquet. Class 3 will be writing historical narratives of stories, packed full of excitement and suspense. Finally, we will end the term writing letters as Romans who have moved to a strange, cold place called Thanet in a recently invaded country called Britain.

Science

Our first topic in Science this year is sound. We will be learning what sound is, how it travels and how we can hear. We will also carry out a science investigation on the question- Did Romans use toilet roll?

Maths

Once we have established where we are in our learning following a few assessments, we will move onto the curriculum where we will focus on number and place value during term 1, moving onto addition and subtraction. Times tables will be a focus throughout this year and time will be spent in class securely learning each time table so that children will know them in the correct order, mixed up and the in the inverse.
