Term 2- Potions

'In God's eyes, everyone is special'

English

In Term 2 we will begin by creating our own potions, writing instructions. Then we will begin to explore our first core text, Alice in Wonderland by Lewis Carroll, writing character descriptions. We will use Shakespeare's Macbeth Act IV, Scene 1, Double, double toil and trouble, learning about rhyming couplets. We will explore play scripts, identifying the features before writing our own based on Roald Dahl's 'The Witches'. Finally, we will explore our new Christmas theme during the final weeks of Term 2.

Science

Our topic for Term 2 is States of Matter, how everything exists in one of these states and how different materials can change state through different processes such as melting, freezing, evaporation and condensation. In addition, we will be completing the partner investigations— Are all liquids runny? How do smells get up your nose? and Is custard a liquid?

Maths

We will continue to develop our understanding of methods for addition and subtraction, both mental and written methods such as the column method. We will then move onto a short unit on measure- length and perimeter, before beginning to learn methods for multiplication and division.

General

Welcome back to Term 2, we hope you all had a good half term and a well-earned rest. Our new topic is Potions, and details of the new homework project were sent home on the first day. This term, there are different options for homework which again were sent home at the start of this week, please feel free to email me if you are unsure in any way.

ICT

Following a recap on how to stay safe when using any technology on line, we will continue to learn about reliable search engines and how to use them effectively for research before continuing to learn what software developers do.

RE

In Term 2 we will be learning about Sikhism, exploring core beliefs and answering the question What is important for Sikh people? Finishing the term learning about how Christians prepare for Christmas.

PE

Class 3 will still have PE on a Tues afternoon, although please could PE kits remain in school at all times. In Term 2, Team Theme will be learning invasion games.
