Dear Parents and Carers,

Class 3 have been fortunate to have been granted a partially funded trip to Brockhill Country Park, Hythe. This is an exciting opportunity to enhance our science learning with some hands-on experiments and fieldwork.

We will travel by coach to the park and return in time for our usual pick-up routines. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, waterproof coat, wellies, water bottle and dress in normal school uniform. We will have use of an indoor classroom for lunch or learning in case of inclement weather, but waterproof coats are essential for this trip.

If your child requires medication during the day, please ensure a medication form (available from the School Office) is completed and the medication is in its original packaging with your child's name clearly stated on it.

The trip has been generously partially funded by Brockhill Country Park. However, we kindly ask for a voluntary contribution of £6 per child to help cover the travel costs. Please make payment via the Arbor App/Portal.

Your consent for external trips has already been given via Arbor, and this will be confirmed when you make payment. Please do ensure that all your contact details are up-to-date on Arbor. To determine the viability of this trip we require payment to be made by Friday, 8th November 2024. If you have any concerns or issues with making payment please contact the School Office as soon as possible for support. Should we not receive enough voluntary contributions, this trip will unfortunately not take place.
