Years 5 & 6 visit to Brogdale Collections- 22nd May 2024

The children will be leaving school at 9:15am and will be returning to school by 3:10pm. Travel will be by seat-belted coach. If your child requires travel sickness pills, please administer them in preparation for a 9:15am departure. If your child requires cover for the return journey, please place the exact dose in a named sealed envelope.

The children should wear school uniform for the trip, with suitable footwear, as they will be outside for the majority of the day. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather: a fleece/coat if it is still chilly, waterproofs if it is rainy and, optimistically, sun cream should also be applied before they come to school if it is sunny. A packed lunch will be required for this day. Do make sure you provide your child with plenty to drink. Please no fizzy drinks in cans and no glass bottles. If your child is eligible for FSM and requires a packed lunch to be provided, please advise the School Office of this by 13th May 2024.

If your child requires medication during the day, please ensure a medication form (available from the School Office) is completed and the medication is in its original packaging with your child's name clearly stated on it. Spending money is not needed for this trip.

This trip provides a great opportunity for the children to immerse themselves deeper into our Sow, Grow and Farm topic, as they will take part in Brogdale's Living Science Day. This trip is kindly subsidised by Brogdale, offering the best value for money that they can provide.
