Subjects	What the children will be learning		
Communication & Language	Children will be introduced to new vocabulary relating to our topics and		
	will be encouraged to use them. Children will be focussing on speaking		
	in fully formed sentences and offering reasons for their opinions.		
Literacy	In literacy we will continue to share lots of books and talk about them.		
	We will continue learning our sounds and begin to blend simple cvc		
	words. In our writing we will look at writing some initial sounds in		
	words.		
Maths	We will continue to look at numbers to 10 and spend some time looking		
	at positional language. We will continue our daily 'Maths Mash Ups.'		
Personal, Social and Emotional	We will continue to develop our sharing and play skills. We will also		
Development	talk to the children about showing compassion to others, animals and		
	themselves.		
Physical Development	Our weekly PE sessions this term will all be about movement and		
	development. The children have been loving our PE sessions so far.		
Understand the World	During our 'Starry Night' topic will be learning all about the world at		
	night time. Then we move on to our 'Winter Wonderland' topic where		
	we learn all about winter.		
Expressive Arts & Design	We will be introduced to 'junk modelling' this term. The children will be		
	using everyday resources to make different things. We will also be		
	making some special Christmas decorations as the term progresses.		
RE	Our big question in Re this term is 'Why do Christians perform nativity		
	plays at Christmas?'		
Relationships and Health	This term all our lessons will be focused on 'resilience. How can we
