

Monkton Church of England Primary School Newsletter for Class 3 Term 1 - Invasion

In God's eyes, Everyone is special.

English

During the first term of the school year, our core text will be The Saga of Erik the Viking by Terry Jones. We will learn what the core reading skills are in order to decode, explore and understand the meaning of texts. We will focus first on understanding vocabulary, learning how to reliably use dictionaries and a thesaurus to look up and find the meaning of words, before moving onto prediction and retrieval skills. In writing, our first genre will be Anglo-Saxon poetry, where we will explore Beowulf, which was believed to have been written about 1000AD. We will identify features of the language and the structure of the poem before writing our own versions.

We will then move onto Playscripts, again identifying features before writing our own simple scripts which we will then seek to act out. Finally, we will read Norse myths, understanding the difference between a myth and a legend.

Science

During this term, we will be learning all about Sound, what Sound is, how it travels and how we hear sounds.

In a separate investigation, we will seek to answer-How did Vikings dye their clothes?

Maths

Times tables will be a focus throughout this school year and time will be spent in class securely learning each time table, so that children will know them in the correct order, mixed up and develop a good and reliable recall speed of each fact. More information will be sent on the first Homework sheet, week beginning Monday 5th September.

The first term will focus on developing the children's understanding of number and place value, moving onto methods for addition and subtraction later in Term 1.

General

Welcome to Class 3, Ladybird class and the start of a new school year. We would like to welcome back our year 4 children and Year 3 to their new class, including 3 new children to our school Margo, Alistair and Logan. Our topic this term is Invasion. There is a slight change for the Team Theme after school sports club. Year 3 will be able to join the club on Tuesday after school, taking part in Outdoor and Adventurous Activities (OAA), with year 4 being able to join the Wednesday club with the same activity. In addition, Year 4 will be able to join Football club run after school on Thursdays. Other clubs will be available for Year 3, more details to follow.

RE

In Term 1, the children will be exploring Christianity, the PEOPLE OF GOD, considering the question- What is it like to follow God?

ICT

During the first term, Class 3 will apply their knowledge and understanding of networks, to appreciate the internet as a network of networks which need to be kept secure. They will learn that the World Wide Web is part of the internet, and will be given opportunities to explore the World Wide Web for themselves in order to learn about who owns content and what they can access, add, and create., and how reliable this is.

PE

Our PE day is now Wednesday afternoon. In term 1, Team Theme will teach Football skills, with the children learning to apply tactics and developing into attacking and defending situations. They will also explore OAA- Using skills to solve problems.
