However, despite this, I can also honestly say that the last couple of terms have been the most rewarding of my career. I am so so proud of what the children have achieved and I'm so very proud of the staff, helpers and parents here, who work tirelessly to ensure our children flourish and get the education they deserve both academically and socially.

At the beginning of the year, the staff discussed how we could make this year extra special for the children. The common consensus was that we need our curriculum to be inspirational and ambitious and flood it with as many experiences as we can to help the children learn from the awe and wonder that they see first-hand.
