(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Monkton Street, Monkton.

A closure is planned from 19th September 2022, with estimated completion by 18th November 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27807876919-01 & GE05085738312-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Monkton Street will be closed between number 46 and number 60, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by Amber Langis Limited.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Monkton Street, Willetts Hill, A299 Monkton Roundabout, A299 Canterbury Road West, Tothill Street, Monkton Road and vice versa.
