What your child needs to bring:

- Towel
- Swimming Goggles
- Flip Flops/Crocs to walk to the pool from the changing area
- Swim Hat (we will provide these, but children are welcome to wear their own one if they have one)
- Hair Bobble - all hair must be tied up for swimming lessons

There are some incidences that your child will not be able to participate in swimming lessons:

- Diarrhoea - not until 48 hours after symptoms reside
- Cryptosporidium - - not until 14 days after symptoms reside
- vomiting - 48 hours after symptoms reside

These guidelines help us maintain a clean, safe, and enjoyable swimming environment for all.

Frequently Asked Questions



What should my child wear for swimming lessons?

Girls must wear a one-piece swimming costume for lessons, and boys must wear swimming trunks or shorts (above the knee). Goggles must be worn, long hair must be tied back.

Does my child have to wear a swim hat?

Yes - all children will be required to wear a swim hat. We will provide these for all children, but they are welcome to wear their own if they have one.

Who is in charge of the chemicals and upkeep of the pool?

Both myself, Kimberley, and our other teacher, Catherine are Level 3 Qualified in Plant Pool Operations and will be keeping the pool sparkly clean throughout.

How many children will be in the pool at any one time?

A maximum of 12 children will be in the pool at any one point, split into two groups with two separate teachers, meaning a maximum of 6 children to one teacher.

Where will my child get changed?

All children will get changed in a designated changing area, separated by gender and supervised by school staff.

What is the depth of the pool?

The pool will be 1.2m deep.

Is the pool heated?

Yes, it will be kept at 28-32 degrees throughout.
