However, due to continued increases to the cost of living, we have had to make the difficult decision to raise the price of Breakfast Club from September 2024. The new price will be £2.20 per session. I hope you'll agree that, with Breakfast Club being open from 7.45am every morning and providing a hearty breakfast of various cereals and toast, it still offers great value for money. The school will continue to fund those who are eligible for Free School Meals.


Breakfast Club will commence from the first day back in Term 1, Tuesday, 3rd September 2024, and should be booked in advance via the Arbor App/Portal. Bookings can be made up to half an hour before the session is due to start. However, we kindly request that you book as early as possible so we can ensure adequate staffing and resources are in place.

Sessions can be booked on a daily, weekly or termly basis. Please ensure you choose the correct option from the drop down box upon booking. There must be sufficient funds in your Arbor account to cover the cost of the sessions being booked. However, no payment will be taken until your child's attendance at Breakfast Club is registered on the day.

SCHOOL CLUBS



Mr Sewell's **Sports Clubs** will run on Tuesdays for years 1-3 and Thursdays for years 4-6. These clubs will focus on local sports events and competitions and those pupils attending the clubs will be selected to represent the school in appropriate events.

Choir will run on Mondays, leading up to Young Voices 2025. The cost is £3 per week, but we ask that your child commits to the full term, as the cost of the club will cover their Young Voices entry, coach travel and event T-shirt.

Whilst we try to avoid cancelling clubs, there may be times that this is unavoidable, so please do not rely on clubs for childcare. We hope to be able to offer wraparound after-school childcare soon.

Football Fun Factory will be back for Term 1 and will run every Monday from 9th September 2024. The club is open to all year groups. ATTENDANCE

In addition to promoting academic and future success, good school attendance is proven to have a positive impact on children's emotional well-being and social development. We have a whole school approach to attendance We urge you to take family holidays during the school holiday periods, ensuring your child has the opportunity to take full advantage of the educational opportunities and engaging curriculum available to them at Monkton.

The Government updated regulations state that 'The school will not be able to authorise holidays requests during term time.' Furthermore, penalty notices now carry a fine of £80 per parent per child if paid within 21 days increasing to £160 per parent per child if paid between 22-28 days. Failure to pay the penalty in full by the end of the 28-day period will result in prosecution by the Local Authority.
