Dear Parent/Carer,

Please find included with this letter a copy of the **Easter School** timetable for year 11 students. This is by no means compulsory but an opportunity for students to have some extra revision support in the subjects offered throughout their holidays and also collect further reward stickers towards their goal of 24. We do have several students that have already completed their first reward card by attending 24 intervention sessions (£20 discount from prom/year book/hoodie) and are now working towards a further £10 reward.

We have analysed outcomes over previous years and last year over 80% of students that attended at Easter and May Holidays achieved grade 4+ in English and Maths and only 40% of those that didn't attend achieved the same measure. We realise lots of different contributing factors go into this statistic – but it does give a general indication about effort and attitude to the approaching exams.

Instructions for the Easter School are on the reverse of the timetable and these have been shared in assembly. Students will need to sign in and out at school reception on the days they are attending to ensure we know they are on site in case of emergencies.

If your son/daughter wishes to attend some sessions they will need to “book” on to the sessions using Eventbrite. The link is here:

There is obviously no cost for the “tickets” to the sessions but it helps us to know the numbers we are expecting to ensure the correct staffing levels and to help with reprographics. They click on **reserve a spot** and **register** but can book on to as many sessions as they wish. We will also send you this link electronically so you don't need to type it in!

Revision should now be well underway. All students were provided with a CGP study guide “How to Revise for GCSE” at the end of year 10, this will help alongside assemblies and tutor periods over the coming weeks and months as we support your son/daughter's exam preparations.
