Dear Parent/Carer

This letter is regarding the new Department for Education “Education Record” App. You may have heard about it in the news.

From this summer your son/daughter will be able to have access to their exam results, schools they’ve attended and any special support needs they are entitled to, on their mobile phone, in order to improve the transition to sixth form, college, or a training provider. It allows them to share information digitally rather than on paper.

Students can share their education record when they enrol at college to make the process smoother. This will also speed up the process on results day and will continue to be updated as your son/daughter progresses through further and higher education. Ultimately, they will be able to share their qualifications with any future employers.

In order to do this they will need to download the app from the relevant app store and then have their account linked via a special portal in school. Their individually generated QR code will be distributed by a member of staff who can verify the identity of your child and link their phone to the app.

On results day all their exam results will be sent to their app centrally from 11am.

If you and your child wish to take advantage of this new initiative please encourage them to download the app onto their phone by 24th February 2026 (when we return after half term).

During tutor time we will be making arrangements for the students, that wish to, to scan their personalised QR code and have their account verified in school. This is not a service we will be able to offer on results day – the student will need to have put it in place before they leave school in June.

Exam results will be available, on paper, from 10am on Thursday 20th August as every other year. We still encourage our students to attend then, in person, so we can celebrate with them and offer support where required. Results will be sent to the app from the DfE at 11am if they have registered for the service.
