22-23		<p>Students can catch the ball in most situations but still need practice in catching with my weaker hand.</p> <p>Marking and dodging is good, regardless of the heed or speed of my opponent.</p> <p>Students do not usually cause contact or obstruction.</p> <p>Students can still make an accurate pass even when being marked.</p> <p>Students can easily use their weaker hand when dribbling.</p> <p>Students know the rules and rarely make mistakes.</p> <p>Students can umpire a skill/game situation. Students have a good understanding of at least two positions and can play them both effectively.</p>							
20-21			<p>Students can catch the ball when it is thrown at varying heights and speeds. They are also beginning to catch with only my weaker hand.</p> <p>Students can dodge and mark most opponents quite well and try to avoid contact or obstruction.</p> <p>Students can throw accurately using a variety of different passes.</p> <p>Students have some success with their weaker hand when dribbling.</p> <p>Shooting is becoming accurate in both practice and game situations.</p> <p>Rules are applied to a game situation.</p> <p>Students know the role of, and can play more than one position.</p>						
19				<p>Students can usually catch the ball when it is thrown at varying heights and speeds, but occasionally drop it.</p> <p>Students can dodge and mark although sometimes cause obstruction.</p> <p>Students can throw accurately using more than one type of pass.</p> <p>Shooting is becoming accurate in a practice situation, but still making mistakes in a game whilst shooting.</p> <p>Students know the rules but occasionally get them wrong, particularly in game situation. Students have good understanding of one playing position.</p>
