Remote Classwork

Montgomery Academy has provided all students with a unique Google Classroom code to access remote school work in the case of absence related to COVID-19. This a directive from the Government which explains that should a student need to self-isolate or there is a local/national lockdown, students need immediate access to classwork. The work set on this platform aligns as closely as possible with the work their peers will be doing in school at the same time.

Accessing and sending work

The Google Classroom code has been affixed into their student planners and is also available in this folder. Students need this code along with their SCHOOL email address in order to access and upload their work back to the teachers. In this folder there is a Loom video presentation explaining how to access the work.

We expect students to take a picture of completed work/complete online quizzes and send work back to their teachers for some feedback/acknowledgement. Another Loom video will be available shortly to explain how students can do this, if they are uncertain.

Monitoring

Staff at school will make contact regarding your son/daughter's ability to access and submit work. We will expect students to be engaging with all the work that is set, following their school timetable as a guide as to when to be completing their work.
