The Queen has announced a special competition ahead of her Platinum Jubilee later this year. The nationwide competition aims to find the perfect pudding that can be served for her Jubilee and beyond. Buckingham Palace has recently unveiled the full line-up of celebrations to mark the Platinum Jubilee this year which, alongside the pudding competition, includes street parties, a concert with some of the world's biggest entertainment stars, a chance to see the Queen's homes and a huge street parade. It will all end with a special four-day Bank Holiday weekend from Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June 2022. On 6th February, the Queen will have reigned for 70 years - she's the first British monarch to reach the milestone.

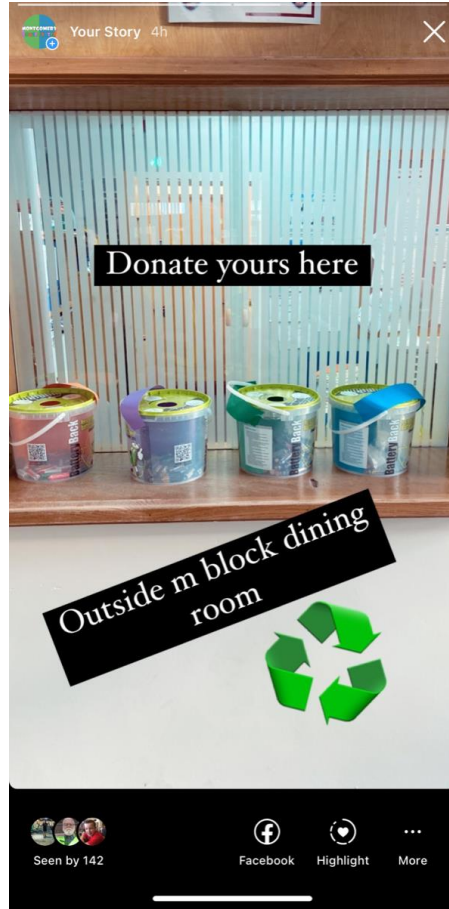
