Should a tunnel be allowed to be built near Stonehenge?

Plans to dig a road tunnel near the ancient monument site of Stonehenge in Salisbury, have been approved by the Transport Secretary, Grant Shapps. A two-mile tunnel out of sight of the monument will be built even though it went against the recommendations of planning officials. It is estimated that the tunnel will cost £1.7 billion to create. The Planning Inspectorate had recommended Grant Shapps should stop the plans, saying it would cause permanent harm to the World Heritage Site. But the Department for Transport wrote to Highways England stating: "The Secretary of State is satisfied that, on balance, the need case for the development together with the other benefits identified outweigh any harm." There is now a six-week period in which the decision can be challenged in the High Court.


