YR7 and YR11 – arrival to school after 8.35am

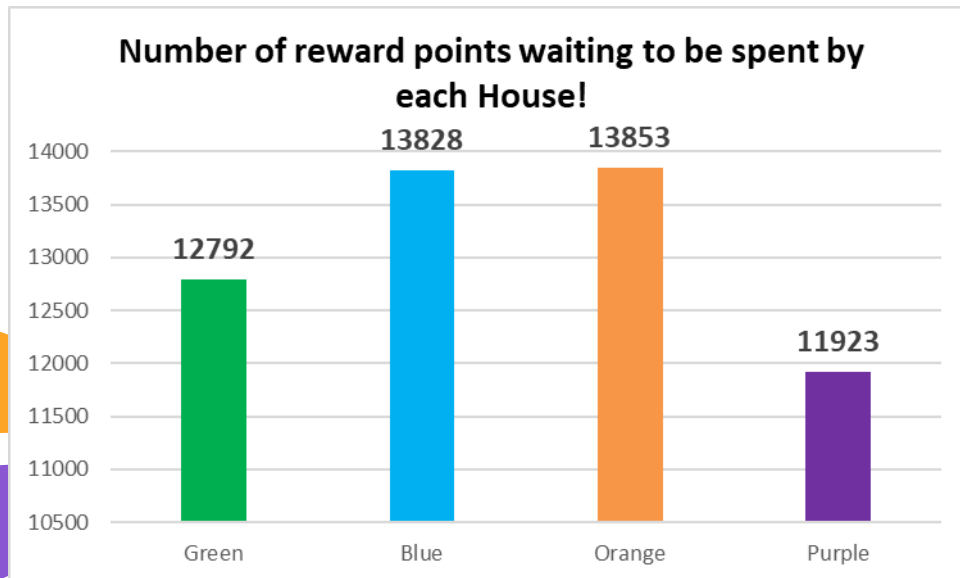
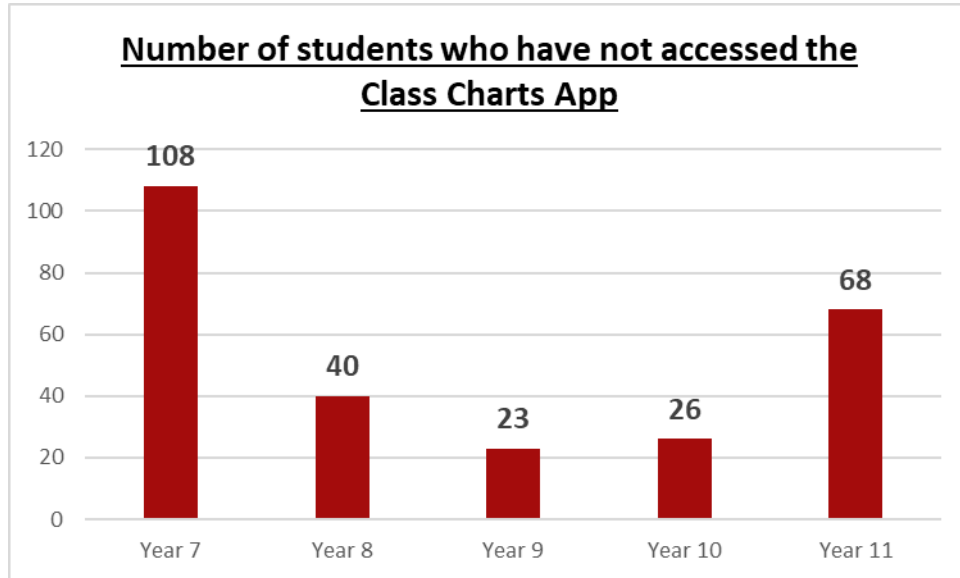
YR9 - arrival to school after 8.50am

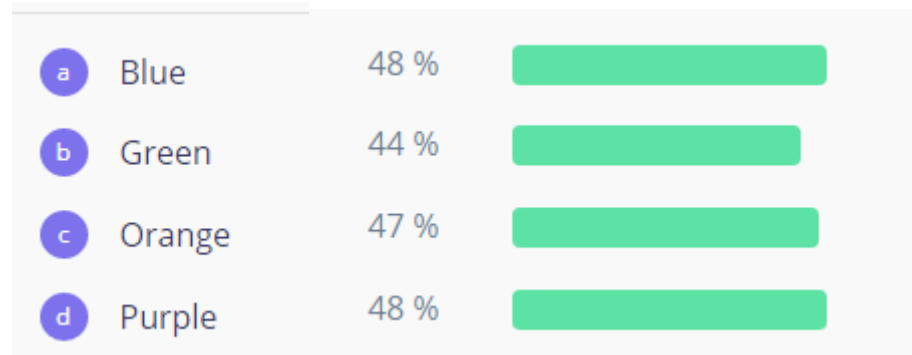

# Do famous people have a responsibility to use their voice to help others?

England footballer, Marcus Rashford has said “I could not be more proud to call myself British” after many authorities went against the Government’s refusal to fund meals over the recent half term break for many children. The 23-year-old said he is “truly overwhelmed” by the support his campaign has received after Parliament rejected proposals to provide free meals to children during the school holidays. Rashford’s powerful campaigning has provided a springboard for the issues of child poverty and hunger onto the front pages of the national media, forcing a government policy U-turn on food vouchers in the summer holiday, and more recently starting a debate in Parliament.
