

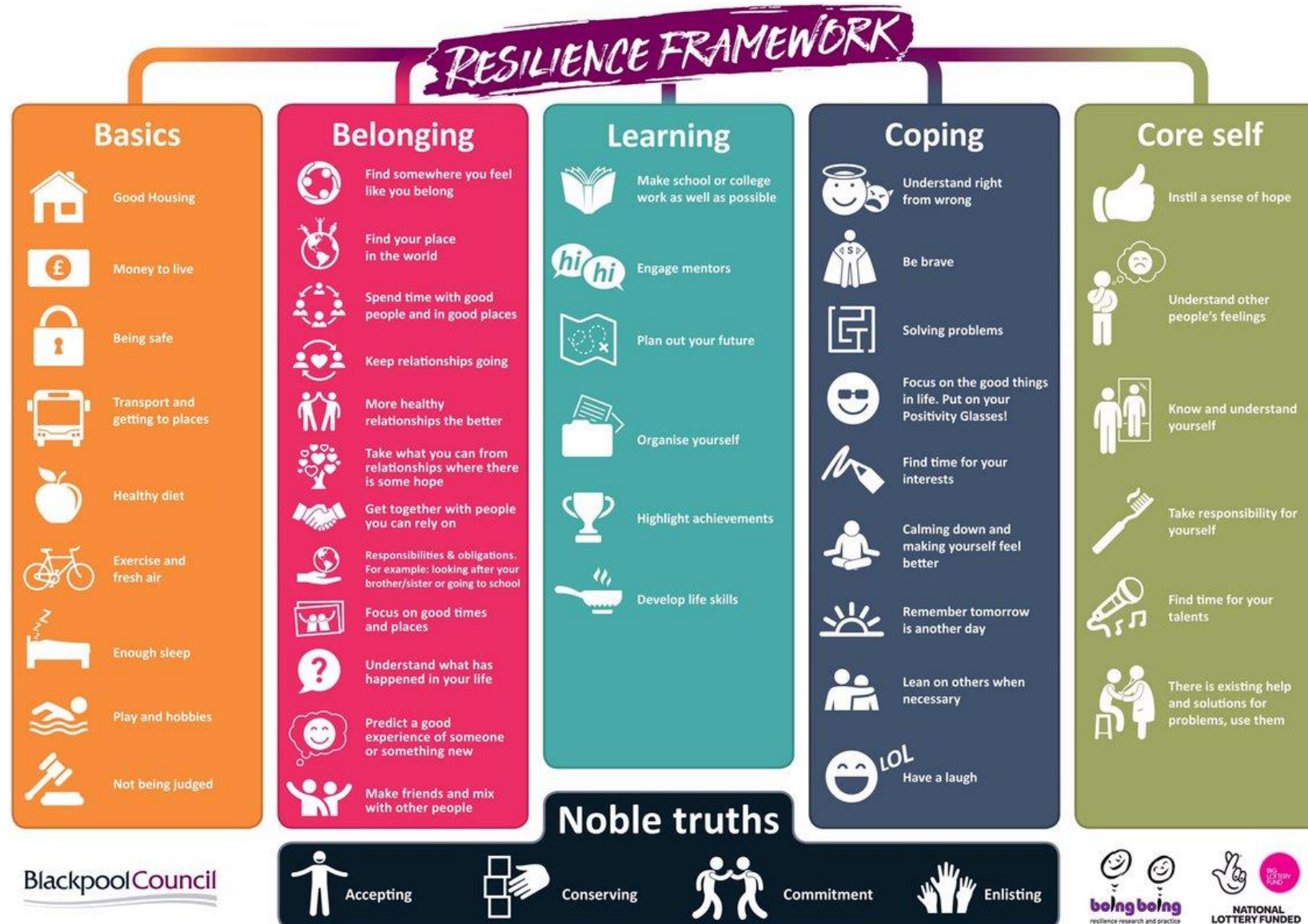

# Should visits to care homes be allowed?

A charity is seeking a review of the government guidance on care home visits. John's Campaign says many care homes in England are still refusing regular face-to-face visits, despite changes at the end of July that outlined new guidance for visitors. Dr Angela McIntyre, who supports the campaign, has not seen her 92-year-old mother since March. A Department of Health spokesperson said, "We know limiting visits in care homes has been difficult for many families. Our first priority is to prevent infections in care homes, and this means that visiting policy should still be restricted, with alternatives sought wherever possible. Visiting policies should be tailored by the individual care home and take into account local risks in their area."
