Question: What role does sport play in our lives?

Six English football clubs announced plans in April to form a breakaway league, which they hoped to create as a new midweek competition called the European Super League. Within days of making the announcement, all six teams had formally dropped out of the competition. Manchester City were the first club to quit after Chelsea had said it would look to prepare plans to withdraw. The other four sides - Arsenal, Liverpool, Manchester United and Tottenham pulled out shortly after. Fans, football authorities and government ministers in the UK, and across Europe, expressed anger at what they said would be an unfair competition that would keep many teams out of top European football. The Super League said it would reconsider "the most appropriate steps" to reshape the project.
