

**Question:** Should everyone volunteer in their spare time?

The Royal Voluntary Service (RVS) has recently marked one year since the NHS Volunteer Responders scheme launched. More than 1 million volunteers signed up, when the public were encouraged to help the health services as it dealt with the increased demand due to the pandemic. The Queen, 94, has been patron of the RVS for almost 70 years and Camilla, the Duchess of Cornwall is the current president. Both joined an online engagement to thank some of the volunteers for their great work during the past year. More than 1.6 million tasks have been carried out by NHS Volunteer Responders through an app called GoodSAM.
