People sometimes sing songs to make their voices heard or to encourage others to think about an important issue such as climate change.



Does music have the power to change our behaviour?

Sing2G7, an ambitious project aiming to give children a voice ahead of the upcoming G7 Summit, has recorded a song at Truro cathedral. The song, titled Gee Seven, has been composed by Peter Hobbs, written by Sir Tim Rice and aims to put children's voices at the heart of the upcoming summit, which opens in Cornwall on 11th June. Sing2G7, led by volunteers, is inviting young singers across the globe to join Cornwall's children to deliver a musical message to world leaders. Already more than 13,000 young voices in 18 countries have signed up to sing, from individuals in lockdown to school choirs, Brownie packs to a South African township choir. More than 100 schools in the UK are taking part as well as 14 cathedral choirs. International sign-ups include singers in Australia, Canada, Germany, Japan, Portugal, Malaysia, Spain, USA and Vietnam.

All you need to do to be in with a chance in the draw is be in school everyday this term.

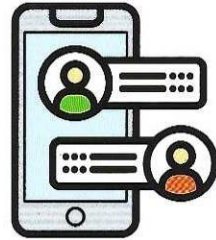
Attendance updates will be sent to your tutor regularly so that you can see if you are in the draw.
