## Year 10 Summer Term Examinations

13<sup>th</sup> May 2024

Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you of the upcoming internal examinations for year 10 students.

Year 10 examinations will take place during June towards the end of the Year 11 GCSE examination series. Most of the exams will take place in the Sports Hall, unless individual students have been told otherwise, under full examination conditions to give the students the experience that they will hopefully undertake next Summer at the end of year 11.

These examinations will take place over three weeks beginning on **10<sup>th</sup> June** and will focus on the subject content they have covered across the year. Your son/daughter's teachers will tell them in lessons, and distribute revision lists, of anything they specifically need to revise. An examination timetable will be sent out in due course.

Please encourage your child to carefully check the information and to note when their exams are taking place in order for them to prepare as effectively as possible. Students must arrive 10 minutes before the published start time in order to be seated on time. Students should bring the equipment required for their examinations in a clear pencil case or see-through plastic wallet. It is essential that they bring a black pen, pencil and ruler to all examinations, and a calculator for maths and science examinations. Water is permitted in a clear, unlabelled bottle. All mobile phones must be switched off and placed in bags. Wrist watches are not permitted, these should either be left at home or placed in bags for the duration of the exam.

Students should line up quietly outside before the exam begins and await further instructions. Exam regulations insist that as soon as a student enters the Sports Hall, they must be silent, and remain so until they leave the Sports Hall after the examination. Students are expected to go to the toilet prior to examinations and will not be permitted to leave an exam to visit the toilet unless we have a medical note/toilet pass. Students will follow their normal timetable when they do not have an examination.
