Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope that your family have had a good half-term and your son or daughter is looking forward to coming back to school tomorrow. I am writing to remind both you and your child of a few important pieces of information.

Firstly, you may be still taking in last night's announcement by the Prime Minister of a new 4-week national lockdown starting on Thursday 5th November. I sincerely hope that this decision will not bring any extra pressures upon your family. It is clear that the current intention is that schools will stay open throughout, though this will be dependent on the levels of available staffing. We will communicate again before Thursday, having reviewed the new guidance due to be published tomorrow. You should assume for now that nothing has changed as to the position before half-term including that clinically vulnerable students should still attend school.

Students unwell or needing to self-isolate

Please can I remind you that if any student is residing in a household where someone or they themselves are showing one of the three main symptoms of Covid-19

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough
- A loss of or change to their sense of smell or taste

They should stay at home and self-isolate for between 10 and 14 days. The person displaying symptoms should book a test.

Also, if a student is experiencing minor symptoms such as

- Aches & pains
- Headache
- Diarrhoea and Vomiting
- Sore throat
- Feeling tired or exhausted
- Rashes

They should stay at home until they are better.

This cautious approach on minor symptoms is for everyone's safety and has been set by Blackpool's Director of Public Health.
