

How important is it for us to know the weather forecast?

A supercomputer is to be developed to support the Met Office in a huge project to improve weather forecasting. The new technology is to be funded by a £1.2 billion investment from the government and will be managed by the Met Office. It is expected the computer will be the most powerful forecasting system in the world and will be able to offer more precise weather and flood updates. The supercomputer will predict climate patterns worldwide, including some of the more severe weather conditions seen in recent months in India and Australia. Chief Executive of the Met Office, Professor Penelope Endersby, said it was a "great vote of confidence in our world-leading" weather and climate centre".


