



Montreal Church of England Religious Education Curriculum Overview- Cycle A

Teaching Christianity and World Faiths in EYFS and Key Stage 1 & 2 (in line with the Cumbria Agreed Syllabus)

In EYFS and Key Stage 1 we follow the Cumbria Agreed Syllabus by teaching Christianity throughout every year alongside Islam as our chosen second faith. Children encounter Christianity through key festivals (Harvest, Christmas, Easter), Bible stories, and experiences of belonging, special people, and places of worship. Islam is introduced through parallel themes. This approach ensures that children learn about similarities and differences between faiths in an age-appropriate, story- and play-based way in EYFS, and then build on this through more structured enquiry and comparison in Key Stage 1.

In Key Stage 2, Christianity continues as the core strand while pupils also study Islam, Hinduism, Sikhism, and Judaism, allowing them to explore a broad range of beliefs, practices, and worldviews. In this way we provide a broad, balanced, and progressive RE curriculum that reflects the expectations of the Cumbria syllabus.
