Identifying Uniform

We have noticed that most children have their school uniform, bags and bottles labelled. Can we please ask that all items of clothing are labelled with your child's name as this will minimize distress for your child in these early days and encourage independence with the new classroom rules.

Water bottles

All children are allowed to bring their own water bottles to school which are accessible for the children and will be encouraged to keep hydrated throughout the day. Please ensure the bottles are sent into school daily filled with fresh water. As we are healthy school, we encourage the children to drink water rather than cordial or fizzy drinks.

Wellies

Over the next few weeks please can you send your child in with wellies (named) that could be left at school in case of bad weather or for messy play in our outdoor area. We do have spare wellies in school so please don't worry if don't have spare ones at home. Thankyou.

Lunches

Currently reception eat their lunches at tables in the classrooms and will be provided with a picnic style lunch bag. Their lunch will include a cold option of a sandwich (tuna, ham or cheese) or a hot option, fresh fruit/veg, yoghurt and a dessert.
